IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE

- The program typically takes 2 12 weeks to organise but can be organised at short notice.
- Positions are available in high quality hotels in Valencia.
- Potential positions available in:
 - Food & Beverage
- Housekeeping
- Sales

- Kitchen
- Reception
- Administration
- Detailed descriptions of potential tasks will be provided once a candidate is selected and approved. Interviews may take place using Zoom.
- Placements can be terminated due to negligence, poor performance, disciplinary issues or criminal behavior or other criteria stated in contract with company.
- Participants will be fully prepared before departure.
- On the first day, participants will receive a full in programme orientation with Partnership International.
- Participants will also be taken to their Host Company by a Partnership International staff member.















On submitting their documents (CV, references, application form and health form) the school or candidates must select when they wish to arrive and specify for how long if this is known to them. Work will then begin on this project.

Once we have received a candidates documentation, the CV has been screened, the candidate has been accepted by us we begin work to secure the candidate's a confirmed placement.

The lead time is organised in the following time-line, for example:



Before arrival the candidate will have their interview/s and **the placement will be confirmed**. The hotel will provide the necessary documentation and all information will be transferred to the school or candidate where applicable.

Once confirmation has been given the candidate will be able to book their flights and any transfers required. Flights must be booked and confirmed at least 2 weeks prior to arrival.

At 2 weeks before arrival, after receiving the flight details we will provide a **pre-departure e-mail** outlining everything the candidate needs to know before arriving in Ireland. **We will inform the hotel of their arrival** and ensure their first day introduction by the hotel is confirmed.

Final payment will be requested.

The candidate will then arrive as planned and **follow the instructions** provided to begin their experience.
